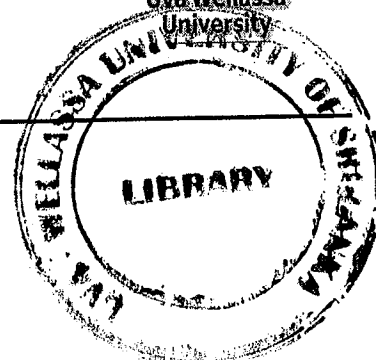

- ii. On K's action if the Land Department arrested him and kept in secret custody without allowing anybody to see him what the relatives of 'K' has to be done. Advice the relatives of 'K'. What the relatives of 'K' shall do?

What is your reply if NICOLOY asked you 'How the special Laws are being enforced and implemented in Sri Lanka?' NICOLOY seeks your opinion on whether special Laws shall exist in a heterogeneous society or not. Advise NICOLOY.
