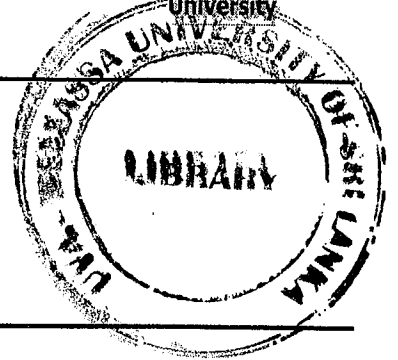

Assume that you have appointed advice the constitutional council of the DHANUSHKALAND in its constitution making process.

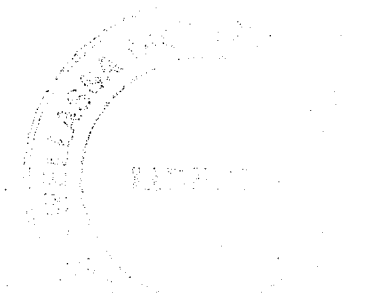
Take into consideration various and numerous types and structures of constitutions of the world advice the constitutional council of the DHANUSHKALAND.
