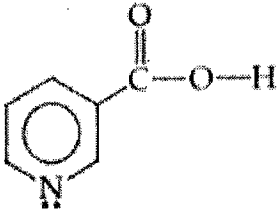


2. Niacin, one of the B vitamins, has the following molecular structure.



the following questions relate to the aqueous solution of the Niacin

- i. Write a balanced equilibrium chemical reaction for aqueous solution of Niacin (25 Marks)
- ii. Write a K_a expression for aqueous solution of Niacin (25 Marks)
- iii. If a 0.020 M solution of Niacin has a pH of 3.26
 - a. What percentage of the Niacin is ionized in the solution (50 Marks)

Note: the rule-of-thumb for the negligence of acid that is ionized with respect to its initial concentrations should be $\leq 5.0\%$. The quadratic equation can be solved using the standard formula of $x = \frac{-b \pm \sqrt{b^2 - 4ac}}{2a}$

- b. What is the acid-dissociation constant, K_a , for niacin (50 Marks)
